



GENERAL ANTI-VIOLENCE AND RESPECTFUL BEHAVIOUR POLICY

To ensure a safe, respectful, and positive environment for all participants, Kanata Gymnosphere reserves the right to remove any child from their registered activity due to excessive or inappropriate behavior. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Acts of violence or physical aggression toward others
- Biting and/or spitting on others
- Pushing others
- Failure to respect other's belongings and personal space.
- Failure to abide by activity rules such as: constant cutting in line, refusal to share space/equipment, refusal to remain with indicated group or within indicated area, etc.
- Repeated disobedience or defiance toward staff
- Bullying, intimidation, or harassment of others
- Use of inappropriate language
- Theft or stealing
- Abusing equipment
- Vandalism or intentional damage to property
- Failure to be fully potty-trained

Failure to abide by the Anti-Violence and Respectful Behaviour policy:

We reserve the right to cancel and remove athletes, campers, and drop in participants that fail to abide by the Anti-Violence and Respectful Behaviour Policy policy from their current and/or future registered activities without facilitating a refund. A credit for the remaining classes, camp days, or drop in will be issued to the family's account, minus a non-refundable administrative fee of \$35.
