



CAMPER BEHAVIOUR & DISMISSAL POLICY

To ensure a safe, respectful, and positive environment for all participants, Kanata Gymnosphere reserves the right to remove any child from camp due to excessive or inappropriate behavior. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Acts of violence or physical aggression toward others
- Biting and/or spitting on others
- Pushing others
- Failure to respect other's belongings and personal space.
- Failure to abide by activity rules such as: constant cutting in line, refusal to share space/equipment, refusal to remain with indicated group or within indicated area, etc.
- Repeated disobedience or defiance toward staff
- Bullying, intimidation, or harassment of others
- Use of inappropriate language
- Theft or stealing
- Abusing equipment
- Vandalism or intentional damage to property
- Failure to be fully potty-trained

If a child is removed from camp for any of the reasons listed above, a credit for the remaining camp days will be issued to the family's account minus a non-refundable administrative fee of \$35. Kanata GymnoSphere does not facilitate refunds.

This policy is in place to protect the safety, well-being, and enjoyment of all campers and staff.
